Intramural Sports
Coed Indoor Soccer

Who can play:

- Full time students and IM card/Recreation card holders may participate in this League.(see Intramural Sports Policies and Procedures)
- Each competitive team may have **NO MORE THAN ONE** current soccer club members per team.

Rules:

- This is a coed sport (At least one of each gender on court at all times). There will be NO goalkeeper in 3v3.
- Kickoffs may be taken in any direction.
- Game length: two 14 minute halves with one 30 second time out per half. Half time is 2 minutes.
- The team who wins the coin flip has the choice of the first kick off or goal to defend.
- **No sliding allowed at any time; one minute penalty, no subs**
- There is no offside at any time.
- Any ball kicked high enough to hit the ceiling or any other obstruction shall be awarded to the other team and be put back in play with an indirect kick from the spot closes to the violation.
- A penalty kick shall be awarded if, in the opinion of the referee, a scoring opportunity was nullified by the infraction. It is a direct free kick from the Half line. At the moment of the kick all players must be 3 yards behind the ball. All foul kicks shall be indirect kicks with the exception of a penalty kick.
- Goal kicks must be taken from any spot along the goal line. The goal kick is taken as an indirect free kick.
- Substitutions may be done on any dead ball. The only exception will be on fouls. Both teams may sub at each others dead ball. All subs must enter the game at mid field. The referee must be notified.
- All out of bounds restarts will be played as a kick-in. The ball must not be moving prior to the kick. This also includes corner kicks.
- Overtime procedure:
 - First team to score wins
- Yellow and red cards:
 - If a player receives a yellow card, then that player must sit out for two minutes. During those two minutes the player may NOT be replaced even if a goal is scored. The team **MUST** play short.
 - If a player receives a red card, then he is ejected from the game. His or her team will play short for five minutes due to the red card. The player must schedule an appointment with the Assistant Director of Intramural Sports

before they can participate in the league again. Two yellow cards in one game equal a red card.

- Mercy rule:
 - If a team has a lead of 5 or more goals in with 3 minutes left in the second half, the team with the lead will be declared the winner and the game is over.
- Forfeit: Score of a forfeited game is 5-0

Equipment:

- No player shall wear padded suits, or any special protective body device. Shin guards are recommended but are not provided.
- No players shall wear eye-glasses unless they are of shatter proof material or contact lenses.
- The Campus Recreation Department will provide soccer nets, game balls and officials. Teams must provide all other equipment including practice balls.
- **No jewelry is permitted during Intramural events.**

Protest:

- Protest must be declared at the time of the incident by the team captain. No protest will be considered based on an officials judgment call, or after the game has been completed. This includes the checking of rosters for illegal players.
